SUMMER CAMP DESCRIPTIONS

Cheshire Cats, Caterpillars, and Rabbits. Oh My! (2 age options)

Join guest instructor Charlene Causey for our first camp geared specifically to our Early Education program! Students will be immersed in the world of Lewis Carroll's classic, *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland*! Ms. Charlene has planned creative movement, stretch routines, and activities related to everyone's favorite Wonderland characters including the Cheshire cat, Caterpillar, and White Rabbit! Snacks will be provided for this camp, but please feel free to bring your own from home!

This camp is shorter than our other camps to accommodate a younger age group and is only being offered June 10-13!

Alice's Wonderland Camp (ages 6-8)

This creative camp is designed with young students in mind. Set to the story of Lewis Carroll's classic, *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland*, we will spend 4 days wandering in Wonderland as we create masks and hold our own caucus race, construct our very own mischievous Cheshire cat and contemptuous Caterpillar that students will animate to music, and even host a "mad" tea party. Ballet classes are included in this camp, and the basis of the classes will be used in the programming we have developed for our adventures in Wonderland. **Students must be fully potty trained to register for this camp.**

Princesses and Pirates! (ages 6-8)

Sail around the world through dance and discover fantastic lands, people, animals, and treasures wherever you go. In this camp we will be learning dance techniques from far off lands such as Spain and Russia and using them to create stories of our own. We will even get to make props and costumes to help us tell our stories, and at the end of our four day exploration we will return home to tell our families what we have learned! Are you a princess or a pirate? You get to choose! Explore your adventurous side with imagination and dance movement! **Students must be fully potty trained to register for this camp.**

Ballerina Boot Camp (Level 1, ~ages 8-12)

Ballerina Boot Camp Level 1 is suitable for students already in our level 1 Ballet program or students who have had at least one year of ballet at another studio. If you have never had dance before and are interested in the School of Dance, we recommend attending one of camps for 8 year olds, or our Youth Ballet class on Tuesdays from 5:30-6:30 p.m. or another open division class! This particular camp is not suitable for beginners.

Ballerina Boot Camp (Level 2-3, determined by director/instructor)

The Level 2-3 Ballerina Boot Camp is open to current School of Dance students who were in level 2-3 as of the end of the spring semester. For current dance students visiting from other dance studios, please contact us to arrange a placement test from our director or instructors to determine your School of Dance level! This boot camp will focus on honing alignment in extensions, turning, timing, and will explore the content of allegro work to prepare students for the upcoming 2019-2020 year. It is also designed to give students further tools for self-reflective and creative practice.

PAYMENT & CAMP CANCELLATION POLICY

- Camp fees are due on the Monday of the selected camp. The student will not be allowed to attend until the fee has been paid.
- No trial period for camps.
- We reserve the right to cancel camps that do not meet the minimum number of enrollees
- Enrollees of cancelled camps will be notified via e-mail, alternatives can be discussed with the School of Dance
- If a camp is cancelled for some reason for which payment has already been made, a refund will be processed automatically in the form of a check

For all camps students should have the following:

Boys/Men

- Fitted t-shirt
- Sweat pants, leggings, or black Microfiber footed tights
- Ballet slippers
- Dance belt (if necessary)
- Other dancewear if you have it

Girls/Women

- Solid colored leotard
(regular class leotard is SO DANCA LILAC SL-07 (child) or SL-06 (adult))
- Leggings or Tights
(regular class tight is SO DANCA TIGHTS TS82 PINK)
- General pink ballet slipper
(Regular class shoe is SO DANCA CANVAS SLIPPER SD16 PINK)

SECURITY

While we do our best to minimize security issues, the Arts Center is a large complex located in downtown Pueblo. It is extremely recommended that parents walk their children to and from class. For security purposes, our front doors may be locked after 8:30 p.m. School of Dance entrance after this time can be through the blue door with a peep hole located between the parking lot and the front door.

If anyone sees suspicious behavior, please let an Arts Center staff member know so they may contact security to investigate.

REPORTING ABSENCES

Please contact the office either by phone or e-mail to report class absences due to illness or some other valid reason. **We do not offer refunds for missed hours or days.**

HAIR

Female

- Hair pulled back into a tight and neat bun secure enough to withstand head movement for turns.
- Short hair must be pulled back with a headband and hairpins to make sure that hair remains off the forehead, face, and the back of neck.

Male

- Long hair must be pulled back away from the face.

ATTIRE

Students should wear outer clothing (sweat pants, jackets, etc.) over class attire. This is for several reasons: protection from weather, prevention of wear and tear on uniforms, and general safety.

ETIQUETTE (for students AND parents)

Please remember the following things during camp:

- No gum allowed
- Do not touch the mirrors
- Do not hang on the barre
- Be aware of other dancers and the space around you
- Do not touch other dancers
- Listen when the teacher or another dancer is speaking
- Ask the instructor for permission to leave the classroom for water or the bathroom (water/bathroom breaks will be provided during the camp)
- Thank your instructor and your parents at the end of the camp day

Parents:

Please make sure your child is on time and prepared (hair pulled back into a clean tight bun, appropriate dress and shoes). Parents are welcome to stay at the School of Dance with their student if they wish. Our lobby and spaces outside of our studios have seating for parents. If the parent wishes to remain in the studio, please observe the following etiquette rules:

- Exit the studio to talk, text, eat, or drink (other than water)
- Silence phones completely (vibration mode is audible and a distraction)
- Praise/guide/discipline your child outside of camp time
