COVID Response Notice

Policies and restrictions regarding COVID-19 are required by government and health department officials, and are subject to change throughout the semester/session. The following statements are currently being enforced campus-wide at the Sangre de Cristo Arts & Conference Center.

EVERYONE ENTERING THE ARTS CENTER BUILDINGS WILL HAVE THEIR TEMPERATURE CHECKED

We are required to health screen and temperature check students and visitors arriving for activities with the Sangre de Cristo Arts & Conference Center. Students and/or Parents/Guardians should expect to answer the following questions by Arts Center staff before admittance into class:

- 1) Do you have any symptoms of COVID-19? I.e. Fever above 100.4F, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, muscle aches, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell?
- 2) Have you come into contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last two weeks?

Students who answer "yes," to either of the above questions will unfortunately not be admitted to class and must be picked up by their Parent/Guardian immediately.

For those whose temperature exceeds 100.4F, we will provide space and some time for the individual to cool down. Temperatures may be retaken up to 3 times, but individuals that continue to exceed 100.4F will be asked to leave campus.

FACE COVERINGS ARE REQUIRED FOR ANYONE AGES 3 AND OLDER ENTERING AND LEAVING CAMPUS, INCLUDING ALL STUDENTS, PARENTS, VISITORS, AND STAFF

Students working in defined, COVID-19 responsive spaces may remove their masks while working within those designated spaces or outside, upon teacher approval.

All students are expected to arrive and leave wearing face coverings, as well as while traveling anywhere on campus

Always maintain a 6-foot distance between other individuals and yourself. Classes are marked with appropriate spacing/work space.

Students are expected to wash and/or sanitize their hands frequently and thoroughly

Please respect staff and signs regarding instructions, off-limits, and closed areas.

At least 2 online activities via Google Classroom are being provided for make-up classes in the event that the campus is closed due to an outbreak, for students who are uncomfortable returning in the current environment, and for those who are sick or must be quarantined but still want the option to participate.

COVID-19 FAMILY HEALTH ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

The enrolled participant(s) and/or parent/guardian acknowledges that due to the contagious nature of COVID-19 and CDC/Public Health authority recommends:

- 1) All visitors to campus, ages 3 and above, will wear a mask properly, over both nose and mouth
- 2) We will practice social distancing: 6-feet of distance between all people is requested
- 3) All visitors to campus (students, parents, staff, etc.) will be temperature checked. Anyone with a temperature at, or above, 100.4F may not be on campus and will be sent home
- 4) Acknowledge that the Sangre de Cristo Arts & Conference Center campus has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19
- 5) Acknowledge that despite all preventative measure and restrictions put in place, the Sangre de Cristo Arts & Conference Center cannot guarantee that participants will not become infected with COVID-19
- 6) Acknowledge that the risk of becoming exposed to and/or infected with COVID-19 may result from the actions, omissions, negligence, or even mere participation in classes of myself an others, including, but not limited to Sangre de Cristo Arts & Conference Center staff, students, and their families
- 7) Acknowledge that we must comply with all policies and procedures set forth by the Sangre de Cristo Arts & Conference Center to reduce the spread while on the Arts Center campus
- 8) Acknowledge that we voluntarily seek the art and recreational activities and services provided by the Sangre de Cristo Arts & Conference Center, and that we are increasing our risk of exposure to COVID-19 by participating in programming

COVID-19 LIABILITY RELEASE

The enrolled participant(s) and/or parent/guardian attests that they:

- 1) Have not traveled internationally within the last 14 days
- 2) Have not traveled to highly impacted areas with the USA in the last 14 days
- 3) To the best of their knowledge, they have not been exposed to someone with a suspected and/or confirmed case of COVID-19
- 4) Have not been diagnosed with COVID-19 and/or not yet cleared, following concern, as non-contagious by state of local public health authorities
- 5) Are following all CDC recommended guidelines as much as reasonably possible and limiting their exposure to COVID-19
