Artist Sonny G. Comes "Home" for Arts Center Performance

America's #1 Most Requested Michael Jackson Entertainer adds Cinco de Mayo Twist

(Pueblo, Colo.-April 19, 2019) The Sangre de Cristo Arts Center announces the final performance of its Regional Series on Friday, May 3, 2019 at 7:30 pm with Sonny G's "American Music Icons." "American Music Icons" is a nationally-touring theatrical revue honoring Jackie Wilson, James Brown, Elvis Presley, Cab Calloway, Little Richard, Michael Jackson and Bruno Mars. This high-energy performance features ninety minutes of classic hit songs, exclusive video sequences, and amazing special effects. Sonny G has now become "America's #1 most requested Michael Jackson entertainer."

"After touring across the country, it feels great to be able to bring my show back home to Pueblo. That's where it all started. The hometown audience has a special kind of energy," says Sonny. Another special twist for this performance is the addition of Grupo Folklorico Pueblo dancers who will join Sonny on stage for a special tribute vignette. This vignette has not been seen yet in any of his national dates and it is in honor of Cinco de Mayo (which is two days after the performance).
