***Color In Color* Exhibition Opening January 18**

Highlighting Minority Women in the Arts

(Pueblo, Colo.-January 6, 2020) The exhibit *Color in Color: Celebrating the Vibrancy of Minority Women* opens in the Sangre de Cristo Arts Center's Regional Gallery on Saturday, January 18. The show runs until April 26 and is guest curated by Christiana Lieberman. In addition to her work with the Arts Center, Christiana is a senior at Colorado State University-Pueblo with a double major in Art History and English.

Says Lieberman, "The beauty of minority women is rarely praised in Western society. This show illuminates the elegance of diversity and celebrates exquisite color." When asked what drove her to choose this topic, Lieberman said that it was a new exploration into an area not usually covered. She chose to invite young, regional, emerging artists to show their work in this exhibition.

Gallery hours at the Arts Center are Wednesday through Saturday, 11 am to 4 pm, and Sunday, noon to 4 pm. Admission is \$10 for adults, \$8 for children, seniors 65+ and military. Arts Center Member are always free. Free days during this exhibit are First Friday Artwalks on Friday, February 7, and Friday, March 6, from 5 to 7 pm and Sunday, March 8, from noon to 4 pm.
