Presenting the Southern Colorado Dance Festival

Weeklong Series of Dance Classes Showcases Love of Motion

(Pueblo, Colo.-April 19, 2019) The Sangre de Cristo Arts Center is excited to announce the inaugural Southern Colorado Dance Festival, August 12-16, 2019. Coordinated by Nanine Wainwright and Brittany Nunes, area dance companies and schools are invited to join the Sangre de Cristo School of Dance for a week of extraordinary dance classes with guest artists extending from across Colorado and the United States.

Festival attendees receive 3 classes a day, a t-shirt, and a chance to perform in the showcase. Tuition is \$300 for the week, dancers from Pueblo and Pueblo West studios receive a discounted price of \$250.

Participating studios are also invited to submit a 3-5 minute piece for a showcase to be presented on the last day of the festival. The piece may include up to ten dancers. Those wishing to submit a piece for consideration should send a DVD to:
